


NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 11

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, December 4, 2012, at 5:00 p.m., at the offices of Mike Stone Associates, Inc., 19875 Southwest Freeway, Second Floor, Suite 270, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Comments and questions from the public.
3. Authorize preparation of Annual Report in accordance with District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and budget comparison.
5. Tax assessment and collections matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, and installment agreements.
6. Operation of District facilities, facilities inspection, repairs and maintenance, fencing at pump station no. 1, proposal for repair of ditch washouts and re-grading of drainage swales, fencing and/or bollards and cables to prevent unauthorized access to installation of levee, and execution of any letters regarding unauthorized use of levee or drainage facilities and imposition of fine.
7. Levee and ditch mowing.
8. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. construction of Middle Bayou detention lake erosion protection and improvements and approve pay estimates and change orders, if any;
 - b. design of emergency operations building and relocation of CenterPoint Energy poles and for vertical inspections and adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Requesting Release of Funds from Escrow;
 - c. outfall no. 2 gabion baskets/rip-rap material and proposal for semi-annual mowing/maintenance;
 - d. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, or plats;
 - e. contract with Berg Oliver for plantings;
 - f. development within or affecting the District; and
 - g. annexation requests and agreements.
9. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
10. Disaster Preparedness Committee matters.
11. Fort Bend Flood Management Association matters/actions, Federal flood insurance legislation, perimeter levee maintenance, and attendance at levee conferences.
12. Reports from Directors and consultants on Greatwood President's meeting and activities and follow up during the month on levee and drainage facilities and other District and Greatwood regional matters, including Greatwood Districts' articles and information for website.
13. Discuss energy contract and options for the District and authorize execution of new energy services contract, if appropriate.
14. Schedule consultant review meeting.


