


## NOTICE OF MEETING

### FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 11

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, September 2, 2014, at 5:00 p.m., at the offices of Mike Stone Associates, Inc.; 19875 Southwest Freeway, Second Floor, Suite 270, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Comments and questions from the public.
3. Authorize auditor to conduct audit for fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.
4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, and installment agreements.
5. Discuss 2014 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate.
6. Letter of Credit Agreement with Compass Bank.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, budget comparison, and adopt September 30, 2015 fiscal year budget.
8. Operation of District facilities, facilities inspection, repairs and maintenance, and execution of any letters regarding unauthorized use of levee or drainage facilities and imposition of fine.
9. Levee and ditch mowing and drainage channel clean out.
10. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. emergency operations building, including review bids for award of contract;
  - b. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, or plats;
  - c. development within or affecting the District;
  - d. plantings in eyelash beds and maintenance costs related to options; and
  - e. water levels in main lake.
11. Emergency Preparedness Committee matters.
12. Community Projects Committee, including public parks.
13. Fort Bend Flood Management Association matters/actions, Federal flood insurance legislation, perimeter levee maintenance, and attendance at levee conferences.
14. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
15. Discuss request from Greatwood Homeowners' Association for funding of landscape barrier to District's detention pond to help prevent unauthorized access off Riverbrook Drive.
16. Reports from Directors and consultants on Greatwood President's meeting and activities and follow up during the month on levee and drainage facilities and other District and Greatwood regional matters, including Greatwood Districts' articles and information for website correspondence regarding construction.
