


## NOTICE OF MEETING

### FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 11

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, December 7, 2015, at 5:30 p.m.**, at the **RiverPark Subdivision Recreation Center, 5875 Summit Creek Dr., Sugar Land, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Comments and questions from the public.
3. Tax assessment and collections matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, and installment agreements.
4. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for Association of Water Board Directors winter conference.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and budget comparison.
6. Authorize preparation of Annual Report in accordance with District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12.
7. Levee and ditch mowing and drainage channel clean out.
8. Operation of District facilities, facilities inspection, repairs and maintenance, and execution of any letters regarding unauthorized use of levee or drainage facilities and imposition of fine.
9. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, or plats;
  - b. capital planning and replacement;
  - c. development within or affecting the District;
  - d. eyelash beds and maintenance;
  - e. water levels in main lakes; and
  - f. update regarding application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Use of Surplus Funds.
10. Community Projects Committee, including public parks and approve contract extension with Icenhower Consulting.
11. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
12. Reports from Directors and consultants on Greatwood Presidents' meeting and activities and follow up during the month on levee and drainage facilities and other District and Greatwood regional matters, including Greatwood Districts' articles and information for website, and Association of Water District directors.
13. Federal flood insurance legislation, perimeter levee maintenance, and attendance at national levee conferences.
