


## NOTICE OF MEETING

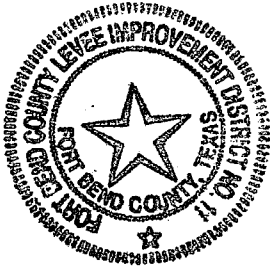
### FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 11

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting on Monday, March 6, 2017, at 5:30 p.m., at Independent Bank, 19855 Southwest Freeway, Suite 100, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Public comments.
3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, and installment agreements.
4. Adopt Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and budget comparison.
6. Levee and ditch mowing.
7. Operation of District facilities including:
  - a. facilities inspection, repairs and maintenance and emergency operations;
  - b. water levels in main lakes;
  - c. semi-annual update from Berg Oliver regarding maintenance of District's bed plantings; and
  - d. execution of any letters regarding unauthorized use of levee or drainage facilities and imposition of fine.
8. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, or plats;
  - b. development within or affecting the District;
  - c. contract for installation of fencing to prevent unauthorized access;
  - d. discuss capital improvement plan, engineering design and bond application no. 4; and
  - e. acquisition of property from Canyon Gate Homeowners association and approve Special Warranty Deed, if appropriate.
9. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
10. Attorney's report, including:
  - a. annual review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance;
  - b. approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12; and
  - c. renewal of District's insurance policies.
11. Community Projects Committee.
12. Reports from Directors and consultants on Greatwood Presidents' meeting and activities and follow up during the month on levee and drainage facilities and

- other District and Greatwood regional matters, including Greatwood Districts' articles and information for website.
13. Federal flood insurance legislation, perimeter levee maintenance, and attendance at levee or floodplain conferences.
  14. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
  15. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
