


NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 11

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, July 12, 2017, at 5:00 p.m.**, at Independent Bank, 19855 Southwest Freeway, Suite 100, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Public comments.
3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, and installment agreements.
4. Discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and budget comparison.
6. Levee and ditch mowing.
7. Operation of District facilities including:
 - a. facilities inspection, repairs and maintenance and emergency operations;
 - b. water levels in main lakes;
 - c. execution of any letters regarding unauthorized use of levee or drainage facilities and imposition of fine; and
 - d. Fort Bend County Drainage District levee inspection report.
8. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, or plats;
 - b. development within or affecting the District;
 - c. discuss capital improvement plan and engineering design; and
 - d. acquisition of property from Canyon Gate Homeowners association and approve Special Warranty Deed, if appropriate.
9. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
10. Attorney's report, including report regarding legislative matters.
11. Community Projects Committee.
12. Reports from Directors and consultants on Greatwood Presidents' meeting and activities and follow up during the month on levee and drainage facilities and other District and Greatwood regional matters, including Greatwood Districts' articles and information for website.
13. Federal flood insurance and State legislation, perimeter levee maintenance, and attendance at levee or floodplain conferences.
