


## NOTICE OF MEETING

### FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 11

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, November 6, 2017**, at **5:30 p.m.**, at Independent Bank, 19855 Southwest Freeway, Suite 100, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Public comments.
3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and adopt Resolution Voting for Director for Board of Director Election for Fort Bend Central Appraisal District.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments and budget comparison.
5. Levee and ditch mowing.
6. Operation of District facilities including:
  - a. facilities inspection, repairs and maintenance and emergency operations;
  - b. water levels in main lakes; and
  - c. execution of any letters regarding unauthorized use of levee or drainage facilities and imposition of fine.
7. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, or plats;
  - b. development within or affecting the District;
  - c. capital improvement plan and design of improvements in the bond application; and
  - d. acquisition of property from Canyon Gate Homeowners association and approve Special Warranty Deed, if appropriate.
8. Phase II MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
9. Proposal for amended District only website and hosting services.
10. Attorney's report.
11. Perimeter Levee joint board meetings.
12. Reports from Directors and consultants on Greatwood Presidents' meeting and activities and follow up during the month on levee and drainage facilities and other District and Greatwood regional matters, open house, including Greatwood Districts' articles and information for website.
13. Federal flood insurance and State legislation, perimeter levee maintenance, and attendance at levee or floodplain conferences.
